

Ableton Live 201 (AL201)

Midi, Production and Arrangement with Live 7

This short intensive course continues from where Live 101 left.

Starting with a refresher on Midi, Ableton's own software instruments are explained and used to add interest to an arrangement. Audio and midi effects are explored in depth, along with more advanced production techniques and tempo operations. Live becomes a powerful tool for audio manipulation even when used in conjunction with other applications through Rewire, and Quicktime support opens additional possibilities.

This second course is particularly useful to musicians and producers who have limited experience with other programs and audio engineering techniques. Very advanced users will probably benefit more from the Live 101 alone, which is more specific to the unique features of Ableton Live 7.

Day 1

- Midi tracks.
- Recording and editing midi clips.
- Snap and quantize in Live.
- Midi controllers and other midi messages in the Envelope box and Arrange View.
- Software Instruments.
- Basic sound-synthesis.
- Midi effects.

Day 2

- Advanced signal routing in Live's mixer.
- Compression and side-chain routing.
- Applied effects: which effects to use and their parameters explained.
- Rewire and other options.
- Watching the volumes and the mix balance.
- Workflow optimization.
- More advanced features of Live 7.
- Working with video.
