

Reason 4 Advanced (PR201)

Course Description

This weekend course is aimed at people that is already familiar with the software's layout and features, and is interested in the creative possibilities offered by Reason as a modular sound-design tool.

Starting from an in-depth look at synthesis and sampling, the course goes on to explore the practical use of splitters, mergers, the Combinator's routing matrix, and many other advanced techniques that make Reason more powerful than many of the most expensive hardware and software synthesizers on the market.
